



## **Launch of ABPN Membership Platform**

### **Dear Members,**

The Association of British Paediatric Nurses are pleased to announce that our new membership platform hosted by VeryConnect will go live this week as of the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024.

### **Current Members**

Current membership details have now been transferred over to the new membership platform and those members who have provided email addresses as part of their contact information will receive an email from the platform with their unique code to log in and update their membership portfolio.

Members who have not provided a current email address will receive a letter in the post confirming the move to the new platform and details of how to log in to the platform to update their membership portfolio.

For those members who currently don't have access to the internet or online facilities, the ABPN Membership Officer will continue to manage their membership through the new platform.

### **Direct Debits**

As part of the new membership platform, members will need to renew their annual membership and pay their subscriptions via the membership platform.

All current direct debit instructions from the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024 will be cancelled.

Members who have paid their direct debits over the last year up to the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024 have had their membership expiry dates updated on the platform.

Reminder emails will be sent to members from the platform 28 days prior explaining that their current membership is due to expire, and they will be asked to provide a link to update and re-subscribe for the following year.

### **New Members**

From 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024 anyone wishing to join the ABPN will be directed to complete an online application form through the ABPN website. The Membership Officer and or administration person for the platform will then authorise the membership which will then enable the new member to continue with the process, and let them forward onto the payment section of the platform.
